## 3. Management of the reserve list and appeal procedure

- Management of the reserve list

The scholarship candidates on the reserve list can receive an EM-scholarship only in case of withdrawal of a student of the main list. The replacement of a "main list" student by a "reserve list" can be done only if $s / h e$ is replaced by the first eligible candidate on the reserve list.

In this particular case, attention should be paid to the EMJMD condition concerning the nationality of the reserve list candidate and to the rule as regards the presence of maximum three nationals from the same country among the scholarship holders for a given category of students (Programme / Partner Country). If this is the case (i.e. there are already three other students with the same nationality on the main list), the consortium will have to take the next eligible candidate respecting its own ranking list. Attention should be paid to the gender balance too. If several candidates on the reserve list have the same ranking, the selection will be made by respecting the gender balance too.

Exceptions can be accepted to the above-mentioned rule: for example, if the withdrawal concerns one candidate going to UPV in year 2, the candidate must be replaced by the first candidate on the reserve list who can go to UPV in year 2 (Spanish requirements).

Some of the candidates on the reserve list who have mentioned the fact they have self-funding possibilities in the application form will be contacted by the emPLANT+ Executive Board for the selection process concerning self-funded applicants.

- Information concerning the selection results

All applicants (both main and reserve list) are going to receive an e-mail from the emPLANT+ Executive Board with information about the selection results.
Please DO NOT contact the Executive Board concerning selection results prior to receive that e-mail.

- Procedure to follow for an appeal to the selection decision

If you want to appeal against the selection decision, the appeal procedure consists in writing to the emPLANT+ Executive Board (emplant@unilasalle.fr) within 7 working-days after receiving notification of your rejection e-mail, in using the emPLANT+ appeal form. Before appealing, make sure your request is justified knowing that the Executive Board receives a high number of applications for a very few places and makes its decision as fair as possible.
After receiving your appeal, the emPLANT+ coordinator will prepare the response which will be submitted to the Executive Board for approval. Before sending the response to the enquirer, the Coordinator might consult with the relevant EACEA staff. You will be notified in writing of the outcome of your appeal within 14 working-days after your appeal submission.
The decision reached by the emPLANT+ Executive Board is final and not subject to further appeals.
